

2024-2025 SCHOOL YEAR

K5 GVL

Parents must choose to enroll their K5 student in either the One Day or Two Day model.

Elementary classes meet for 12 weeks in the Fall and 12 weeks in the Spring for a total of 24 weeks. Each class day starts at 9:10am and finishes at 2:30pm.

In K5 classes, the children are with the same teacher the entire day and stay together as a group, with the exception of a music or art class where they go to the respective teacher for that time. The students enjoy recess twice a day at either the playground or the gym. Parents must pack snack and lunch for their student. Children in K5 will not be assigned homework, except for an occasional oral presentation requirement. Formal grades are not given in K5 but teachers do send home progress reports twice a year. On the last day of co-op, we have a K5 Graduation ceremony that all graduates and their family and friends are invited to attend. A non-refundable \$5 graduation fee is applied for those enrolled in K5.

Course Description

ONE DAY MODEL:

In this model, the K5 class is made up of different class themes each week. Examples of weekly themes are All About Me, My Family, Five Senses, several weeks of fall themes such as Apples, Pumpkins, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Winter, Fairy Tales, Farm, Community Helpers, etc... Each week literacy, math, social studies, and science skills and concepts are included in large group activities and in small group learning centers. The children gain social skills, practice problem-solving, and learn

about themselves, their environment, and others through active play. They are encouraged to love learning, develop early literacy skills, and interact with others in a classroom setting.

Both science and social studies content will be covered at co-op, along with age appropriate calendar skills and various reading and math skills will be practiced weekly. On the four days per week that students are home, parents should focus on Math and English Language Arts content areas using whatever curriculum you have chosen to work through with your K5 student.

Music Class: Students attend music class each class day. The students will enjoy experiencing music in a variety of ways. We explore music through a repertoire rich in folk songs, nursery rhymes, and traditional singing games. We learn about music through imitation, movement, listening, visualization, improvisation, finger play, and rhythm instruments. Seasonal music activities are incorporated throughout the year.

TWO DAY MODEL:

In this model, the K5 class is made up of different class themes each week. Examples of weekly themes are All About Me, My Family, Five Senses, several weeks of fall themes such as Apples, Pumpkins, Thanksgiving, Christmas, Winter, Fairy Tales, Farm, Community Helpers, etc... Each week literacy, math, social studies, and science skills and concepts are included in large group activities and in small group learning centers. Students who attend the two day model will learn about the same theme for both Monday and Wednesday each week and will be able to do more activities and dive deeper into their weekly themes since they will have two full class days together. Both science and social studies content will be covered at co-op, along with age appropriate calendar skills, math facts and sight words will also be practiced weekly. On the three days per week that students are home, parents should focus on Math and English Language Arts content areas using whatever curriculum you have chosen to work through with your K5 student.


Students also enjoy Music and Art class once weekly as part of their class day.

- **Music Class:** Students will attend music class once a week. The students will enjoy experiencing music in a variety of ways. Students will put their learning in action by completing an art project each class day using a variety of media and hands-on learning.
