Introducing BJU 2nd Course FREE for UHC

Bob Jones University provides high school juniors and seniors their first on-campus dual enrollment course for **FREE**.

And now, a special agreement with BJU and UHC provides eligible juniors and seniors at UHC a **2nd on-campus dual enrollment (one semester) course** for **FREE**.

Here's how:

1. Email the BJU Dual Enrollment Advisor at the First-year Experience Office at fye@bju.edu to register for your second course. If you have questions and are not sure which course is best for you, the DE advisor will be glad to help you select a course.
2. Refer to this page for course information - <https://www.bju.edu/academics/high-school-oncampus.php>
3. Receive confirmation by email from the FYE office that you have a seat in the course.
4. Complete the UHC 2nd Course Free Agreement Form.
5. Have the UHC director scan the agreement to financialservices@bju.edu or drop off at the Student Services Hub (Student Center, 2nd floor).
6. Credit will be applied to your BJU account once Financial Services has processed the agreement form.

Courses are one semester in length. The 2nd course voucher is not eligible for online courses.

1st semester registration ends Wednesday, August 20, 2025.

Don't delay! Courses fill up and books need to be purchased.

BJU classes begin Wednesday, August 27, 2025.
